<u>General Session VIII – Managing Problems & Stress</u> – Julia Morelli, President, George Mason University Instructional Foundation, Inc. (Hall of Valor)

Conflict occurs when there is a violation of expectations. Conflict often results in stress, and stress creates conflict. Eustress is a positive form of stress having a beneficial effect on health, motivation, performance, and emotional well-being. It occurs when the body and mind have a positive response to demands and pressure. Problem solving for one (PS1) is a framework that helps guide an individual, or team, through a conflict or a situation that needs to be resolved. Understanding the nature of conflict, and its effect on the body and mind can help reduce stress, making problem solving more accessible.
